



## GUIDANCE FOR ADDITIONAL ADULTS ON SCHOOL TRIPS

All adults who accompany school trips must adhere to the following guidance. The guidance should be given to such adults before the trip.



- → ALWAYS position yourself at back while the teacher is leading front of the line
- → ALWAYS make sure children are walking on the inside of the pavement
- → ALWAYS make sure children are in pairs
- → ALWAYS support the teacher in crossing roads
- → ALWAYS make sure all adults and children know who is in their group
- → ALWAYS check you have packed lunches, first aid kit and identity stickers
- → ALWAYS assist teacher by `head counting'
- → ALWAYS have a trip timetable
- ALWAYS remember you are responsible for every child in your group



- ➔ DO NOT answer phone
- → DO NOT put yourself or others at risk
- → DO NOT be distracted or gossip
- ➔ DO NOT go to the shops
- → DO NOT leave group unattended
- DO NOT swear or use inappropriate language
- → DO NOT let children wander off
- DO NOT smoke
- → DO NOT leave belongings unattended
- DO NOT allow children to shout or run wild
- DO NOT let children eat 'en route' (no sweets)
- DO NOT give parents too much responsibility
- DO NOT let children go to the toilet alone
- → DO NOT lose track of time
