

English: We will be following a text-based curriculum covering these books:

- 'March On' Linked to Martin Luther King for all Learning Groups.
- Roald Dahl's 'Boy' and 'Kensuke's Kingdom' for Mr
 Walker's, Miss Povey's and Miss Slaney's Learning Groups
- 'Why the Wales Came' and BFG for Mrs Blunden's Learning Group
- Miss Papa-Adam's Learning Group will be continuing with Fresh Start

<u>Maths</u>: We are following the New National Curriculum which organises work into units of work. The children are in learning groups according to their needs and rate of progress. Homework is set in these groups. Any work you would like to do with your child at home could involve:-



- 1. Learning certain maths facts by heart so that the children develop the ability to recall these facts instantly.
- 2. Playing a game with cards or dice.
- 3. Investigating number patterns.
- 4. Shopping and pocket money problems.
- 5. Use 'MyMaths' site please see homework tasks or booster packs.

IPC Topics:

During Term 1 our Year 6 classes will be following a unit of work on a theme that focuses on forces entitled <u>Fairgrounds</u>. In Term 2 we will be covering invaders and invasions through The Great the Bold and the Brave. These unit is part of our **International Primary Curriculum**, through which subjects are integrated

together within a topic. Aside from the subjects of the curriculum, children also learn how to be responsible, independent learners, as well as developing understanding of international issues and the interdependence between countries and cultures.



<u>Computing</u>: Using a computer based world, the children will decide how 'objects' interact with each other. They will also program how they are controlled and develop this world into a Mars simulation based on NASA's rover project. Using a coding language, the children will explore loops and subroutines. (Repeating Programs). In the classroom the children will develop their digital literacy skills and e-Safety understanding.

<u>Music:</u> Lessons will be taken by Mr Langridge. Year 6 will focus on keyboards.

Art: Art will be linked to the units covered, more details to follow.

<u>R.E:</u> The whole school meets most days for collective worship. In class we will look at Sikhism in Term 1 and Christianity in Term 2.

Homework Tasks and Supporting your child at home:

The computer suite in open from 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm every day for parents and children to complete homework.

Library lunchtime open days for pupils: the timetable will be confirmed soon.

♦ Just a reminder that English Homework is set on a Monday and a Friday evening and maths is now set using the MyMaths website. Topic work is to be carried out on a Wednesday. If no specific

homework has been set then timetables, general research and extra reading should be undertaken. Children should be doing at least 30-35 minutes.

- *SPELLINGS are set each week by the learning group teachers.
- ♦ MATHS: times tables and maths tasks are set each week.
