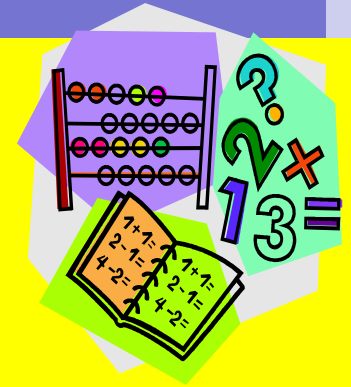

Please ensure items are named and updated to your child's class!

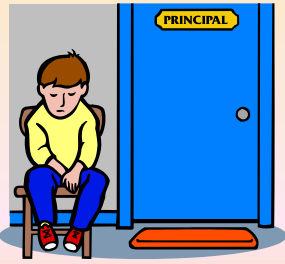


Support Groups

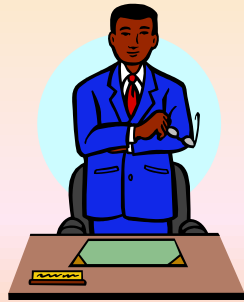
We try to arrange additional support groups to help pupils improve academic skills during assembly times, and during the afternoon.

These will include groups for Reading/Spelling/Writing/FIZZY/Maths and Social Skills.





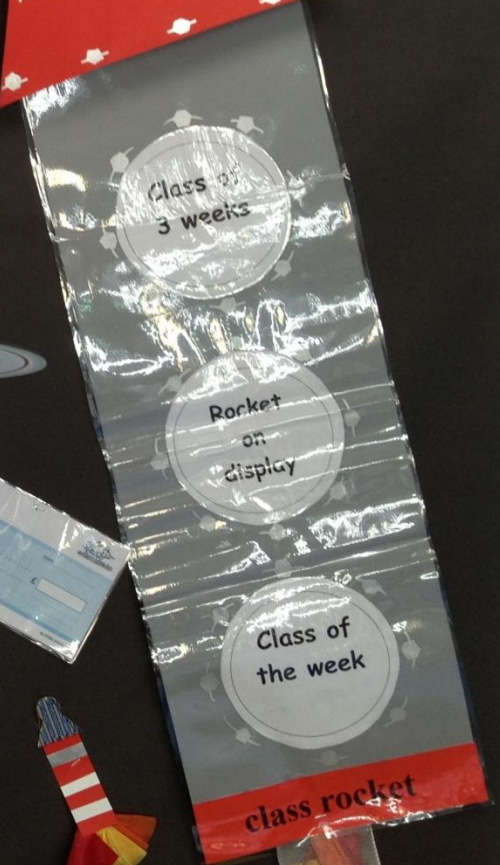
Poor Behaviour



We are here to learn. Behaviour for Learning helps us learn.

- Verbal warning – the teacher will warn the child that their behaviour is not appropriate classroom or playground behaviour.
- If they continue to misbehave – the child will be given a Yellow CARD. This means they will lose 1 of their behaviour points.
- If they continue or the behaviour is thought to be more serious then they may receive a RED CARD. This means 2 points are taken off the total of 5.
- Cards can be redeemed during the lesson if a child makes an effort to change their behaviour.
- Cases of serious misbehaviour will be dealt with by the Year Leader of the Senior Leadership Team.
