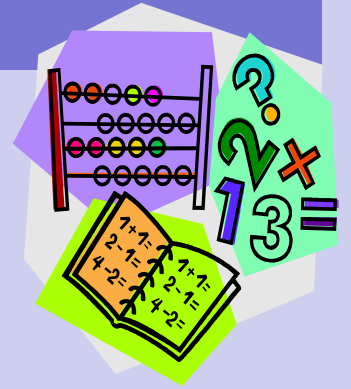

Support Groups

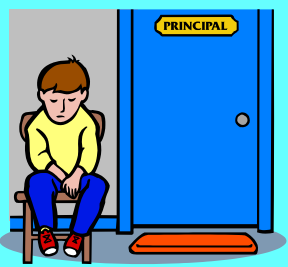
We try to arrange additional support groups during assembly times, as much as possible, to avoid disruption during the afternoon sessions, however there may be a few during the afternoon.

Comprehension/FIZZY/Maths

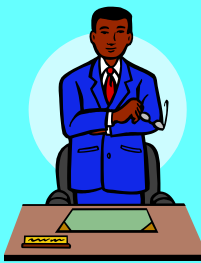

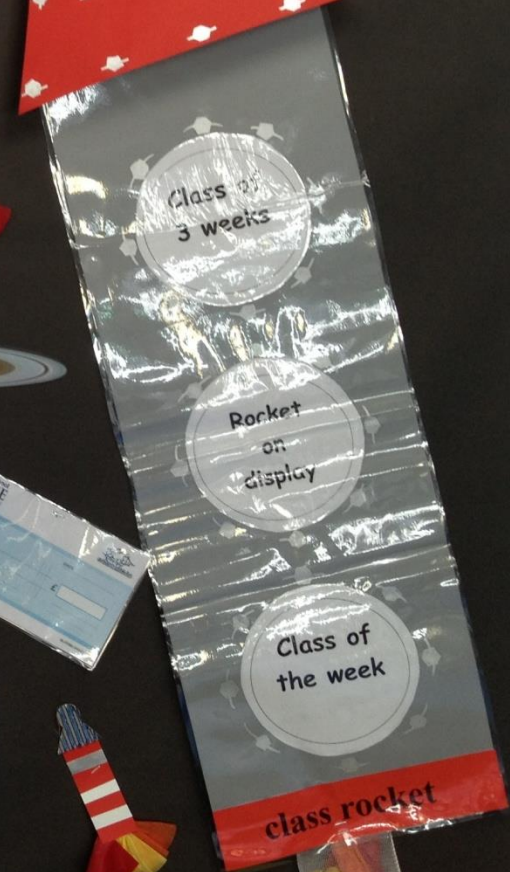


Behaviour



- Verbal warning - the teacher will warn the child that their behaviour is not appropriate classroom or playground behaviour.
- If they continue to misbehave - the child will be given a YELLOW WARNING CARD. This means they will lose 1 point.
- If they continue or the behaviour is thought to be serious then they may receive a RED CONSEQUENCE CARD. This means 2 points are taken off the total of 5.
- WARNING and CONSEQUENCE CARDS can be redeemed!!!!
- Learning Group teachers will share with the class teacher who has lost points during the morning and points will be updated on the computer.
- Play time/Lunch time - Yellow Card & Red Card system still apply.
- Sent to Mrs Blunden or Miss Arthur.
- There will be an end of term reward for those who have kept at least 98% of points
- Badges will be issued when 3 complete weekly cycles and lanyards after 4 badges.
