Dear Year 6 Parents & Carers,

As your child is currently in Year 6 in one of our Viking schools, I am writing to you to share information regarding a **secondary school with a difference**...

The schools in Viking Academy Trust have developed a link with **Christ's Independent School**, which is a co-educational boarding school for 900 pupils aged 11-18 situated near Horsham in West Sussex. Sometimes known as 'The Bluecoat School' – because of the very distinctive school uniform – Christ's is one of the **leading independent schools** in the country. It provides a first class academic education to talented pupils from all over the country and



offers unparalleled facilities for activities outside the classroom such as Sport, Art, Music and Drama. This is all set in stunning countryside half way between London and Brighton.

What makes Christ's very different to other independent schools is the fact that it <u>offers many</u> <u>more bursary places than other private schools</u>. The school was founded in 1552 with the aim of providing

education and nourishment for destitute children in the City of London. Today it remains committed to those charitable aims; educating the financially, socially and otherwise needy for free or at a substantially reduced rate. 14% of pupils pay no fees at all and 35% of pupils pay no more than 10%.

Christ's Hospital is now looking to recruit more pupils who would benefit from assisted places, from the coastal areas of Kent: hence the desire to forge links with the Viking Academy Trust. There are tests for entry to the school. These are similar in standard to the selection tests for entry to Kent Grammar School. It is also important to point out that bursary places are offered on a means- tested basis; they are awarded to pupils where there is evidence of financial or social need.

This is our third year working in partnership with Christ's. We have a number of Viking families that have taken the brave, bold step to be part of this exciting adventure, with

children successful in **gaining** Christ's as their secondary school.
