NHS Test and Trace has identified my child as a close contact of somebody with symptoms of confirmed Covid 19	 Do not come to school Contact school to inform us Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum of 14 days) The rest of the household does not need to self isolate 	The child has completed 14 days of isolation.
NHS Test and Trace has identified a household member or you are aware you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid (other than my child) as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed Covid 19	 The household member must self isolate for 14 days Child can continue to attend school 	Child can continue to attend school.
A sibling attending another school has been sent home to isolate due to there being a positive case in their school	 Sibling must isolate for 14 days Child/Children attending our school can continue to attend 	Child can continue to attend school
My child has travelled abroad to and from a country that IS on the quarantine list. I have travelled from a country that requires us to quarantine but my child didn't travel	 As long as you do not have/have not had symptoms in the last 14 days your child can continue to attend school. The person who has travelled MUST NOT leave the house, including to do pickups and drop offs. 	Child can continue to attend school.
My child's "pod" is closed due to a Covid 19 outbreak in school	 Child must not come to school Child must not come onto the school site Support your child at home with remote learning provided by the school via Microsoft Teams or on the website Your child will need to self isolate for 14 days Other siblings may continue to attend school 	School will inform you that the pod will be reopened
I am unable to get a test for someone in the household who has symptoms	If you are not able to get a test in the first 5 days of having symptoms, your child and anyone they live with must stay at home and self isolate for 14 days. Anyone in your support bubble must also stay at home.	The child has completed 14 days of isolation.
