Year 4 Topics





English: We will continue to follow the 'text-based curriculum' designed around children reading a text over 4 weeks. The authors in Terms 1 & 2 include Roald Dahl and Michael Morpurgo. The term begins by examining

black history, focussing on a book about the life of Jessie Owens. The 'Read, Write Inc.' programme will be followed by children who need extra grounding in reading, writing and phonics.

Within the 'text-based curriculum' key skills of spelling, grammar writing, reading, vocabulary building and speaking and listening will be taught.



Maths: We will be following the new maths curriculum which is 🚓 , organised into 7 concept areas. The children are in learning X 🚰 groups according to their needs and rate of progress. A target map showing key areas of learning will be sent home

for your information. Homework is set using MyMaths, an online program, and weekly tables. Expectation of tables to be known in each year group has increased with the new curriculum. Children in Year 4 should now aim to know all their tables up to 12x12. Keep working on helping your child learn their tables forwards, backwards and in random order, along with guick-fire mental arithmetic calculations.

Topic Work: This year sees the introduction of the IPC (International Primary Curriculum) at Upton. Foundation subjects such as History, Geography and Science will be taught and linked through different topics, so it will be an exciting year ahead. Year 4 topics for term 1 and 2 include BRAINWAVE—finding out how we can become better learners, BRIGHT SPARKS - electricity, circuits and magnets, ACTIVE PLANET - earthquakes, volcanoes, water cycle and solids, liquids and gases. CHRISTMAS—lots of art and craft going on for this topic.

ICT: Mr Jackson will be teaching computer skills to the children on a Wednesday afternoon. 4B, 4G terms 4, 5, 6 and 4R, 4Y in Terms 1, 2 and 3. The children will start to write their own 'algorithms' to program online models. They'll use a coding language to produce an interactive quiz and animations.
