

English: During Terms 3 & 4 we will continue the text-based curriculum & will be reading:

Learning groups 5&6 will be continuing with the Fresh Start Programme and will be reading the books above as part of Guided Reading.

During the 2 week cycle all learning groups will focus on comprehension, grammar, punctuation, spelling and performance.

Maths: We are following the Revised National Numeracy Strategy which organises work



into units of work. The maths investigation focus is 'All Possibilities'. The children are in learning groups according to their needs and rate of progress. Homework is set in these groups.

Any work you would like to do with your child at home could involve:-

Learning certain maths facts by heart so that the 1. children develop the ability to recall these facts instantly. 2.

IPC Topics

Term 3 - The Maya

Pupils will be learning about an ancient civilisation - The Maya. The topic will begin with a chocolate tasting session and end with an afternoon of dance as pupils interpret the music of the Maya.
