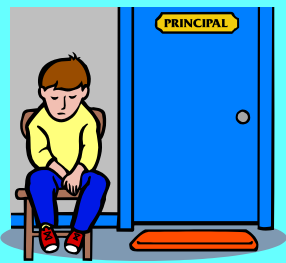
Class Assemblies will begin with 5R in Term 1. 5G, 5B and 5Y will follow after Christmas.

Parents are welcome to attend class assemblies and the poetry performance. More detail will be given nearer to the time.



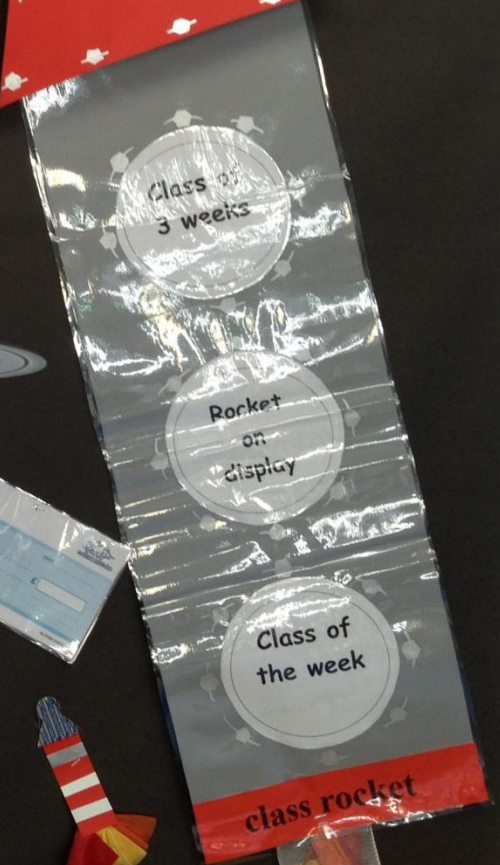


# Behaviour



- Verbal warning - the teacher will warn the child that their behaviour is not appropriate classroom or playground behaviour.
- If they continue to misbehave - the child will be given a **YELLOW WARNING CARD**. This means they will lose 1 point.
- If they continue or the behaviour is thought to be serious then they may receive a **RED CONSEQUENCE CARD**. This means 2 points are taken off the total of 5.
- **WARNING** and **CONSEQUENCE CARDS** can be redeemed!!!!
- Learning Group teachers will share with the class teacher who has lost points during the morning and points will be updated on the computer.
- Play time/Lunch time - Yellow Card & Red Card system still apply.
