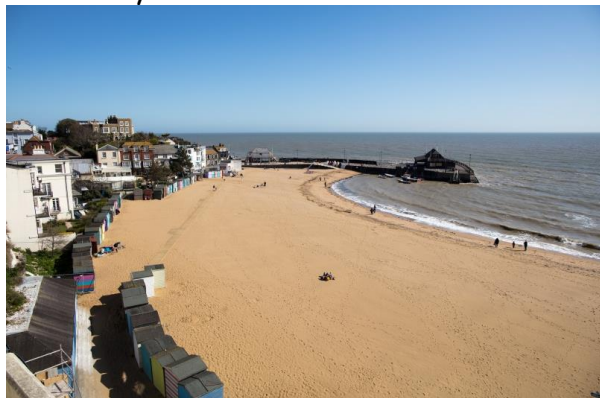

Year 5 End of Year Celebration:

On Tuesday 19th July, we will be taking the year 5 children to the beach (Viking Bay) to celebrate a fantastic year!



We will be departing shortly after 9:00am and intend to leave the beach at 2:30pm so we are back at school for normal finishing time.

On the day children will be allowed to wear non-school uniform. They will also need to bring with them the following:

- A beach towel
- Plenty of water and drinks
- A packed lunch – the kitchen will provide a packed lunch for those in receipt of free-school meals.
- Up to £5 to buy an ice-cream, slushie or food from the beach cafe.
- They can bring with them beach balls, footballs, frisbees and any other beach activity including buckets and spades. However, the children are responsible for their own belongings and will have to carry them to and from the beach. Mobile phones and electronic devices are not allowed.
