We would be delighted if you are able to buy these books and read them with your child at home. It will help develop their fluency in reading and understanding of the text.

Learning groups will be continuing with the Fresh Start Programme and will be reading the books above as part of Guided Reading.
During the 3 week cycle all learning groups will focus on comprehension, grammar, punctuation, spelling, performance and writing tasks.

Maths: We are following the new NC which organises work into units of work. The maths investigation focus is Logic Problems. The children are in learning groups according to their needs and rate of progress. Homework is set in these groups.
