Dear Parents and Carers,

Howletts Zoo Trip - Tuesday 18th June 2024

Year 5 have organised an educational visit to Howletts Wild Animal Park on Tuesday 18th June, which links with our English text and Thematic learning.

The children will need to arrive at school for **<u>8.30am</u>** and we are hoping to return by **<u>3.30pm</u>**. Please note that this is **after** the usual school finish time. Should there be any delay in our return journey, the school office will endeavor to keep parents informed.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle (with enough water for the whole day) in a rucksack. Children who receive free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch. Children will need to wear full school uniform; however, they can wear comfortable trainers as there will be lots of walking on the day. Children need to come prepared for all weathers including a sun hat/cap, sun cream and waterproof coat or jacket.

There is a gift shop, but please limit spending money to no more than £10.00. This **must be in <u>cash</u>** and please ensure money is in a <u>named</u> purse/envelope.

Please let your child's class teacher know if there are any medical requirements above those, we are already aware of.

Children will need to be responsible for taking travel sickness pills if they need them, both before school and before the journey back. Any medication also requires a medical consent form completed <u>https://app.keysurvey.co.uk/f/41495001/48ae/</u> along with the medication in a clearly named envelope to the office by Friday 14th June.

If your child has a Howletts pass, please bring it into school by Friday 14th June 2024 as we will need to take it with us. These will be stored safely in the office.

The cost of the trip will be £21.23, which includes entry to the park and the cost of the coach.

If your child holds a pass, the cost of the trip will be £11.23.

Payments for the trip can be made on your MCAS app under Trips. We are asking for 2 instalments of £11.23 due by 22nd March, followed by ± 10.00 on the 22^{nd} April.

For those with a pass we are asking for \pounds 7.23 on the 22nd March and \pounds 4 on the 22nd April.
