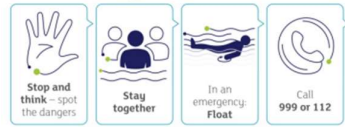


Water World Homework Grid

Water Safety Code



Draw or paint a river scene.



A rivers depth will rely on rainfall. Make a rain gauge and keep a record of how much rain falls in 3 weeks. Produce a table or graph to show your results.

Design and make a 3D model of a river. Can you label it with it's features too?

Make a poster explaining how the particles are arranged differently in solids, liquids and gases.

Write a story with a water or river theme. Maybe a river monster comes to life?



Make a comic strip of the water cycle with a water droplet of your main character.

Create your own water themed maths problems to share with the class!

Design and make a bridge to cross a busy river.



Keep a diary of what you use water for at home for a week. Write an explanation why water is so important.

Produce a fact file about one of the world's rivers.



Design a unique umbrella that can be used throughout the year.



On a world map, identify the major rivers or seas and oceans of the world.

Make up a song, rap or dance about rain!



Create your own poem about water.
