Term 1: 'Prehistory Rocks!'

Choose one or more activities to complete.

Make up a quiz with facts about The Stone Age. Make sure you also have the answers!	Draw a Hunter Gatherer – label the clothes and tools; the materials they were made from, and the properties of the materials used.	Create a menu for a Stone Age restaurant. Think carefully about what food and drink would be on offer.
Design and make an ancient stone circle or a replica of Stonehenge. Be creative in the way you make your stone circle.	Create a timeline of events and changes from this period. Use your knowledge of ordering numbers to ensure the events are placed accurately on the timeline.	Compare your life with the life of a child in the Stone Age. Was there anything that was the same as life today? You might like to write a list or draw a table to explain your ideas. What was different? What was the same? (Homes, families, food, towns, education)
Create your own shoebox Stone Age scene.	Research anything that you find interesting about the Stone Age. Think about a creative way to share your knowledge with others. E.g., A large poster, a presentation, or a game	Stone Age people built shelters to live in using materials they had gathered. Gather some natural material and build a model shelter.
Find out about Stone Age animals. Create an alphabetical list with illustrations.	Create a piece of cave art using materials of your choice.	Create a leaflet for 'How to survive the Stone Age.' Imagine you are transported back to the Stone Age and need a guide to help you survive. What would the guide say? What tips would it have?
